- Report it to site administrators.
- \cdot Ask them to remove the photo.
- · Report it to the police or get legal advice.
- · Tell a trusted adult and ask for their help.

It is not OK to:

- · Pressure someone to send sexy photos.
- · Share sexy photos with your phone.
- · Post sexy photos online.
- · Use sexy photos for revenge.

Remember:

- · Everyone has the right to say 'No' to anything they don't feel comfortable doing.
- · It is illegal to take, send or post a photo or video of anyone (including yourself) under the age of 18.*
- * Sexting is considered Child Pornography under the Commonwealth Criminal Code 1995


